CHAPTER 01

1.1. Brief History - Open University of Sri Lanka

The Open University of Sri Lanka (OUSL) was established as a national single mode distance teaching University in 1980 under the Universities Act No. 16 of 1978 and the Open University of Sri Lanka Ordinance No. 03 of 1980. The University incorporated within its system the External Services Agency (ESA) and the Sri Lanka Institute of Distance Education (SLIDE). The Open University is one of the 15 national Universities enjoying the same legal, institutional and academic status as any other national University in Sri Lanka. However, it differs from the other national Universities because of its dependence on open distance learning philosophy to expand opportunities for higher education regardless of age, previous qualifications, income, geographic and employment barriers. The OUSL commenced its Academic activities on 22nd July 1980 with Dr Gamani Corea as the Chancellor and Professor PD Gunatillake as the Vice Chancellor.

The OUSL is unique within the University system because of its significant feature of offering programmes of study leading to certificate, diploma, degree, postgraduate diploma and postgraduate degree through the distance mode. In a context where access to higher education is limited due to lack of places in the conventional university system, the OUSL has contributed considerably to meet the needs of the country by providing opportunities to gain advanced degrees for the adult population and thereby ensuring the professional development of the work force.

The OUSL which opened its doors with nearly 4000 students has now been expanded to accommodate a student population of approximately 40,000 from all over the island. The strength of the OUSL by the year 2018 is manifest from 24 academic departments attached to five Faculties. The regional service network of the OUSL includes 09 Regional Centres and 19 Study Centres scattered all over the island. Its sixty two (62) academic programmes include 14 Certificate Programmes, 09 Diploma Programmes, 17 Undergraduate Programmes, 05 Postgraduate Diploma Programmes, 13 Master Degree Programmes in addition to MPhil and PhD degree programmes. The university further offers 04 other courses for regular students and about 41 short courses.

The staff strength by the year 2017 stood at 339 Teaching staff (Permanent Cadre) and 615 Non Academic staff (Permanent Cadre) to cater to the needs of the student community. The achievements of the OUSL have been significant over the years and this increasing trend would undoubtedly be further strengthened.

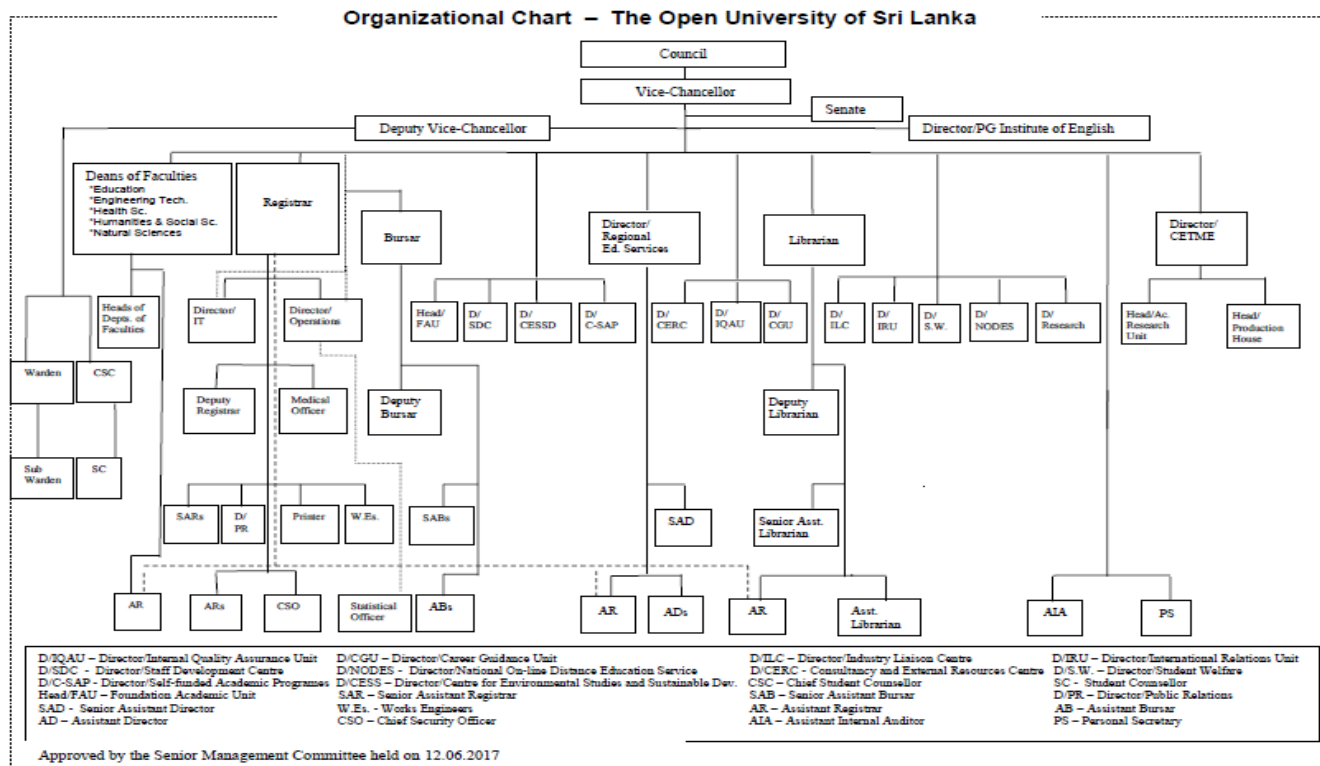

Chart 2.1.1 Student Enrolment

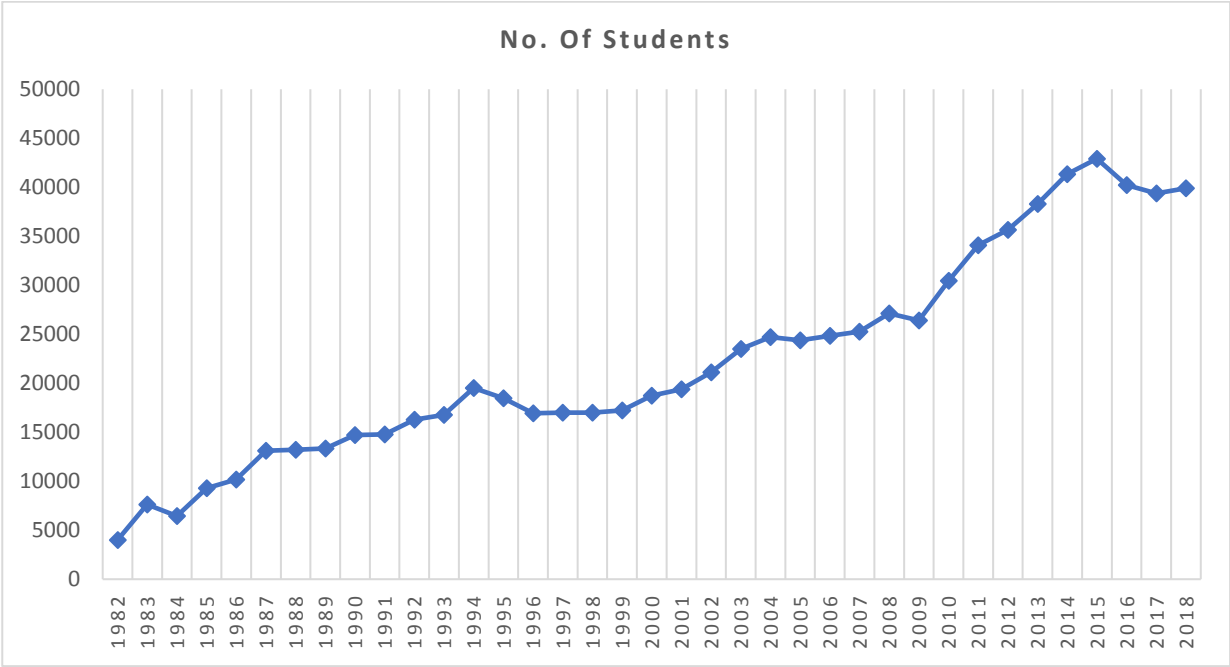

Chart 2.1.2 - Student Enrolment by Programme of Study – 2018

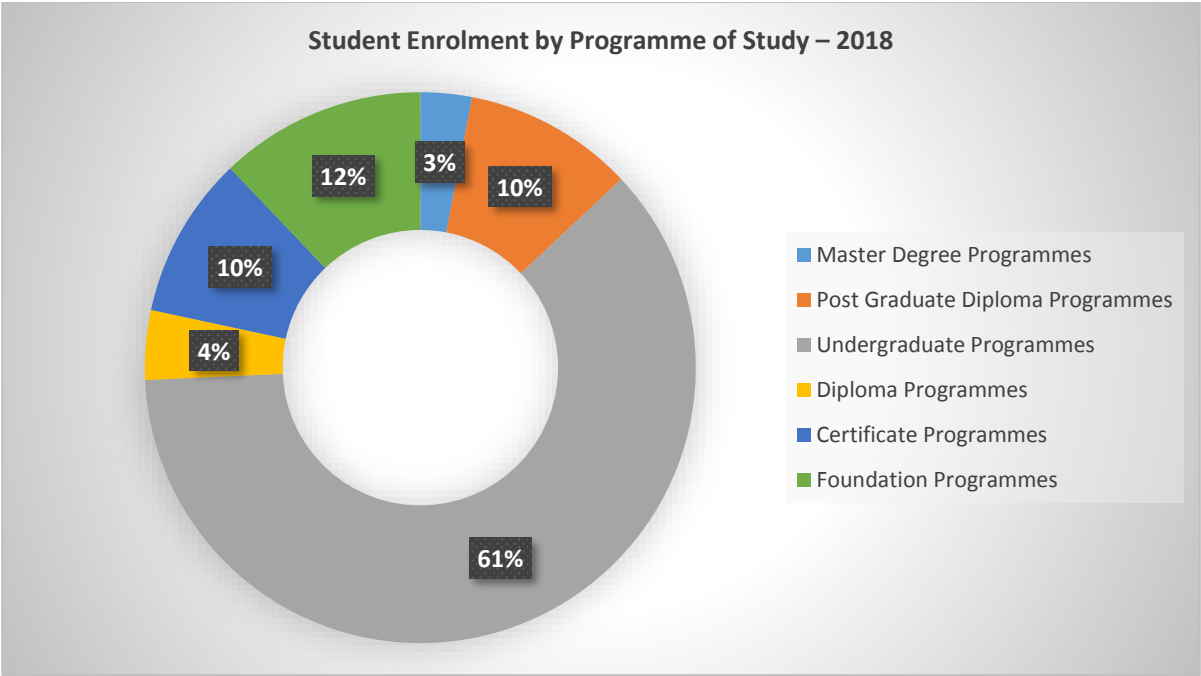


Chart 2.1.2 - Faculty wise Distribution of Students (2013-2018)

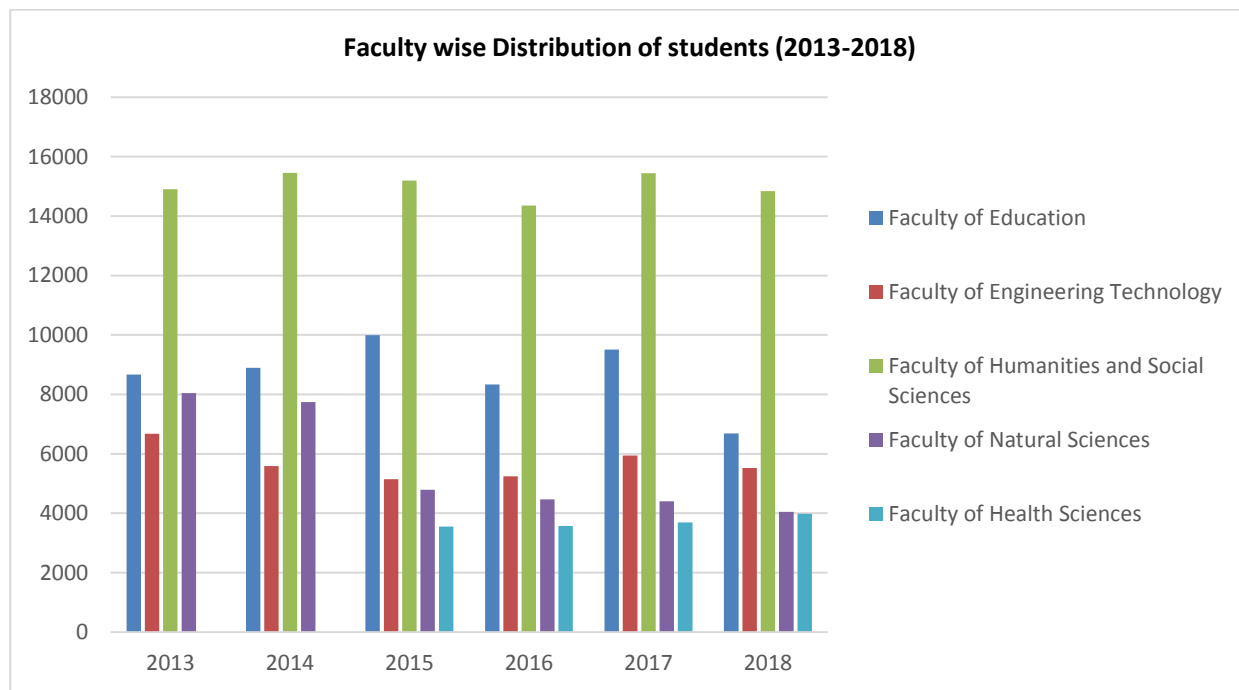

Chart 2.1.4 - Gender Distribution of Students by Faculty – 2018

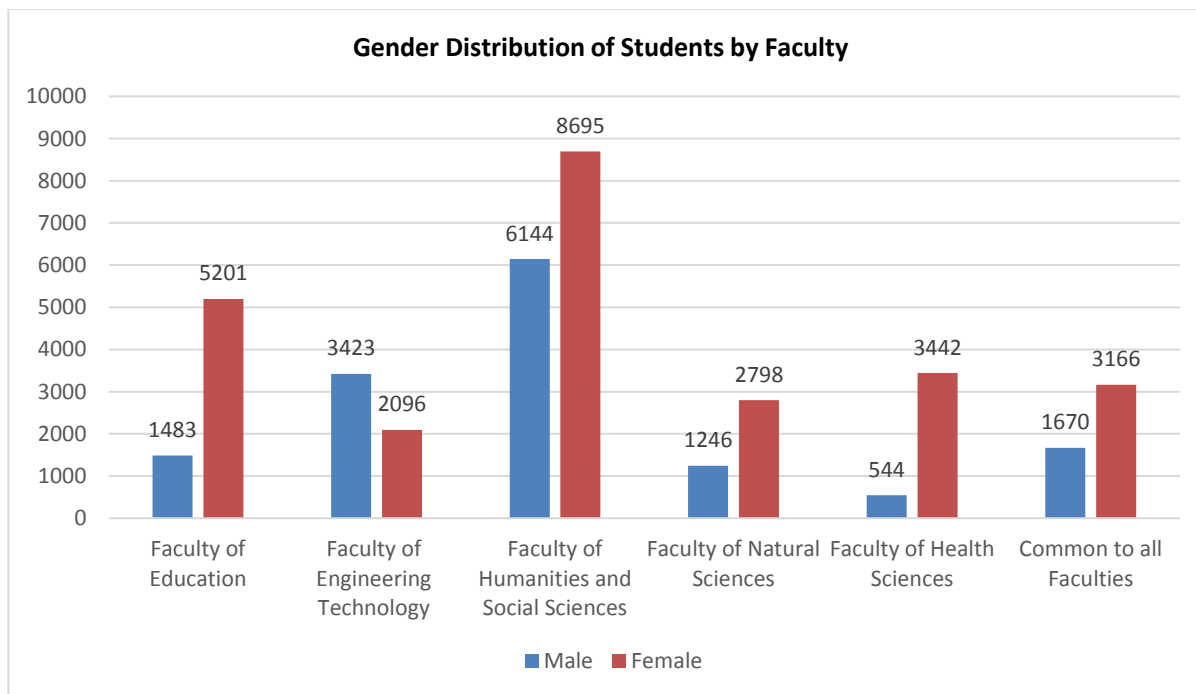


Chart 2.1.5 - Gender Distribution of Students by Level of Programme 2013-2018

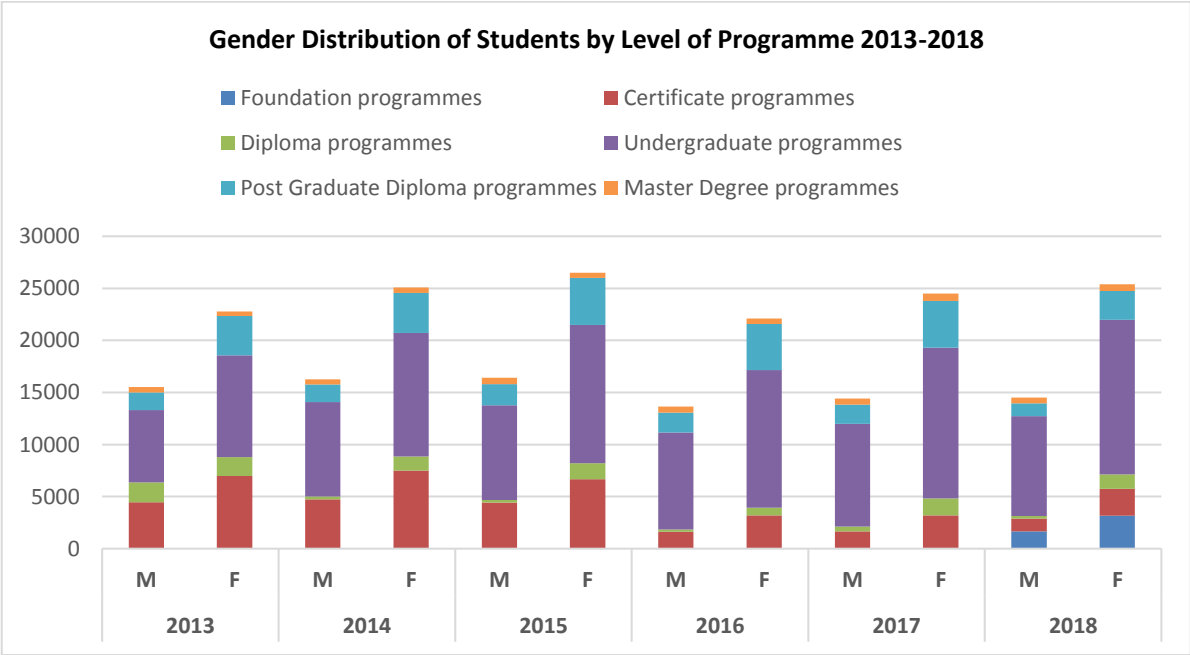

Chart 2.1.6 - Student Enrolment by Medium and Level of Program – 2018

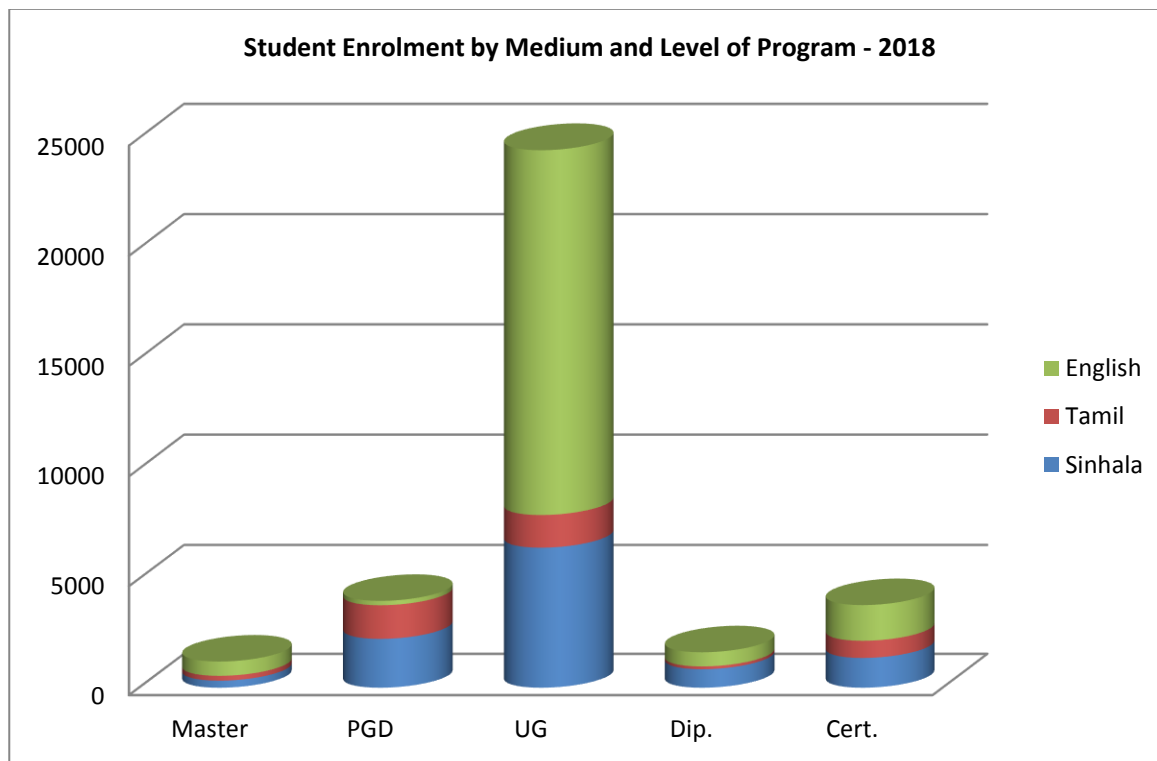


Chart 2.1.7 - Student Enrolment by Medium and Faculty - 2018

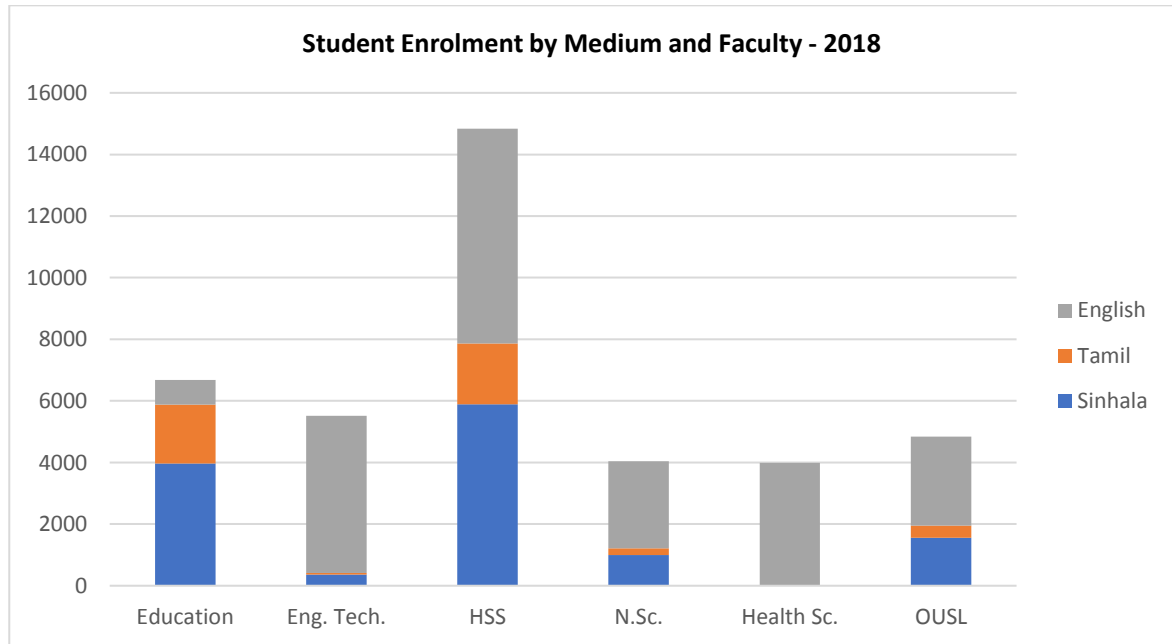

Chart 2.1.8 - Student Enrolment by Province -2018

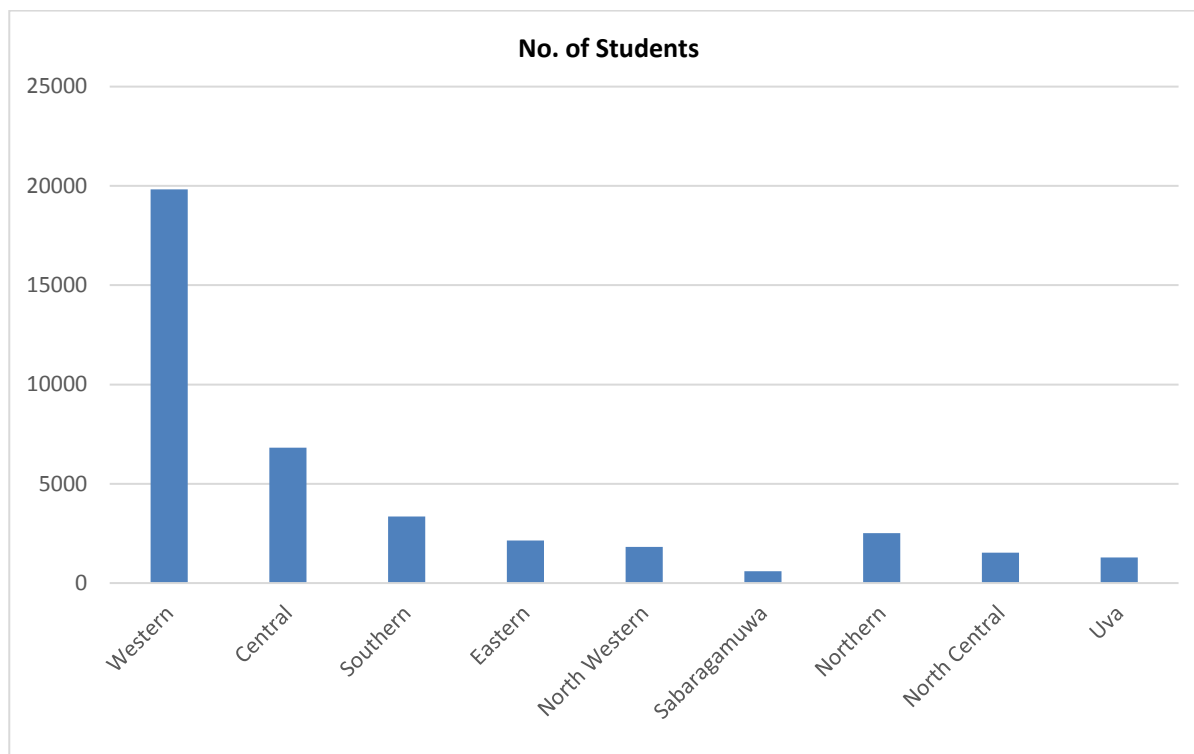
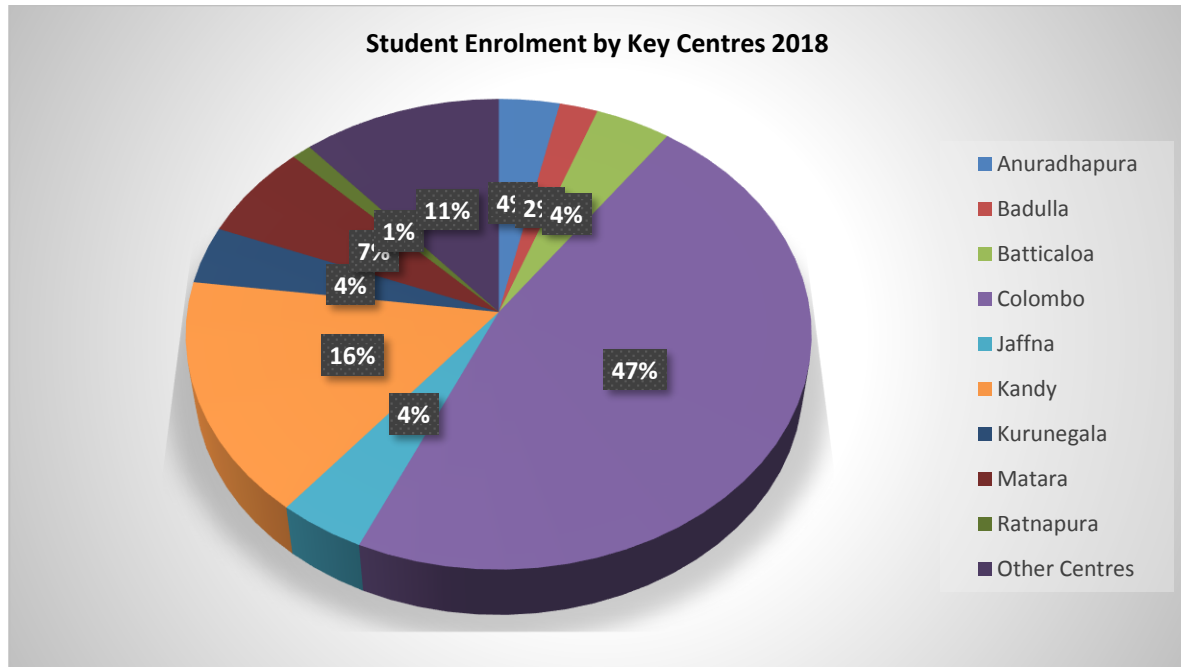


Chart 2.1.9 - Student Enrolment by Key Centres 2018

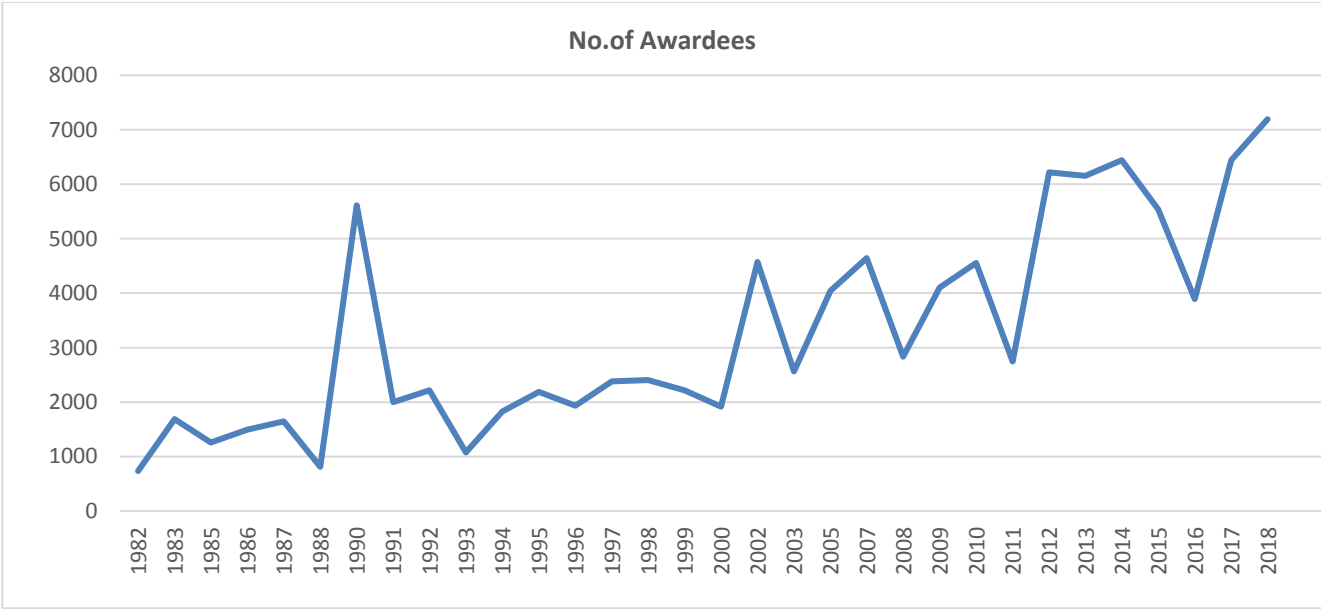

Chart 3.2.1 - Distribution of Awards by Faculty - 2018

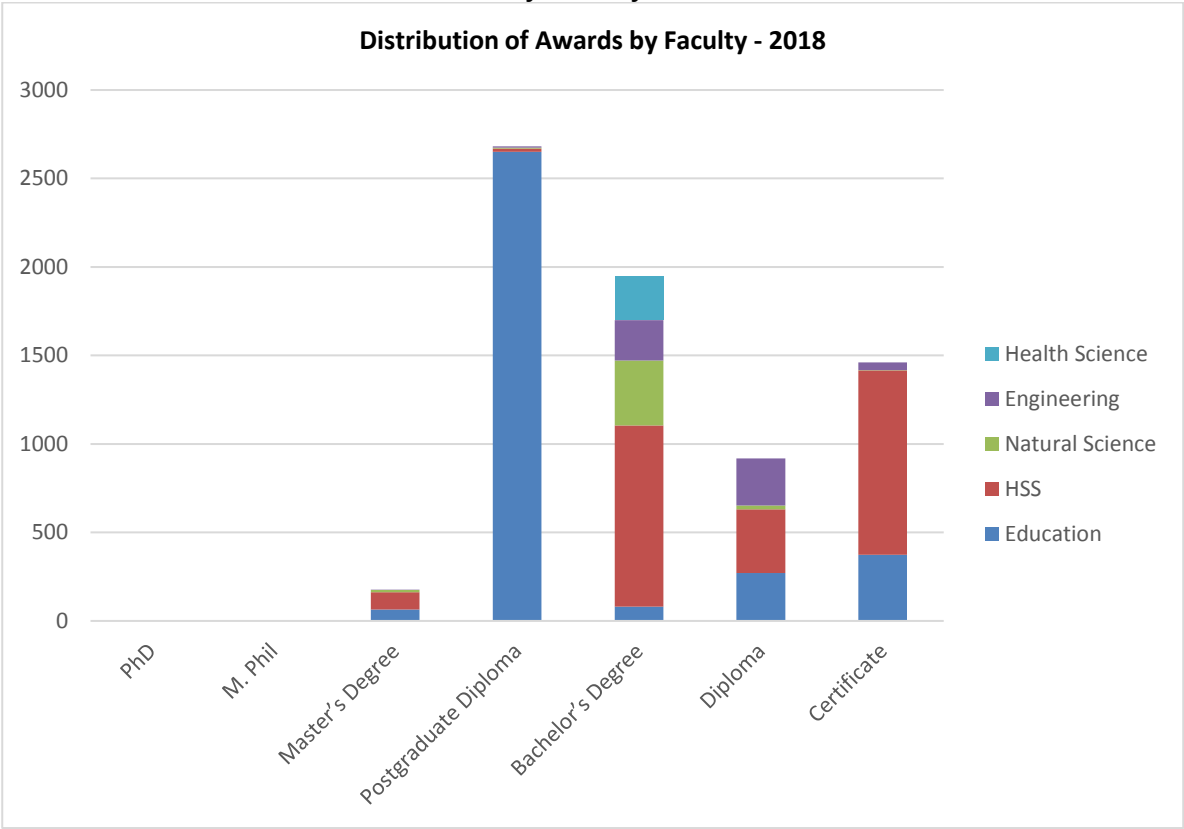


Chart 3.2.1 - Distribution of Awards by Centres - 2018

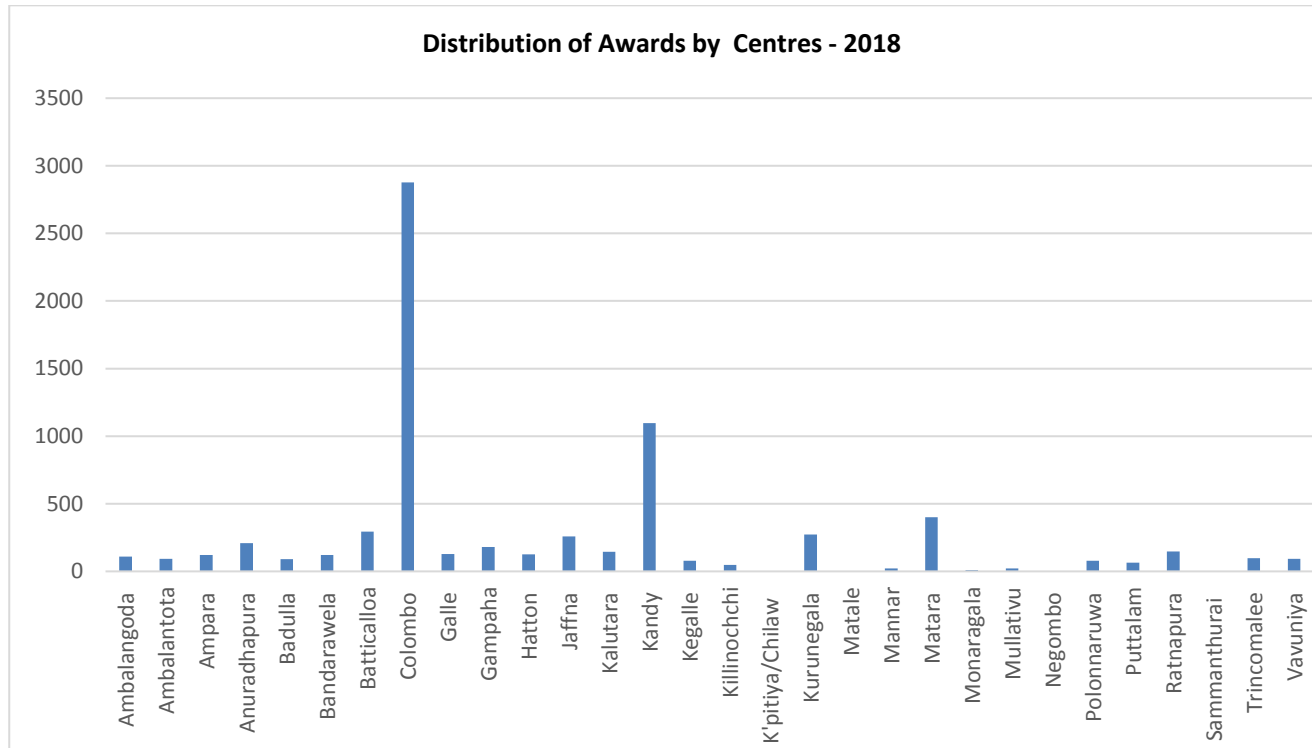

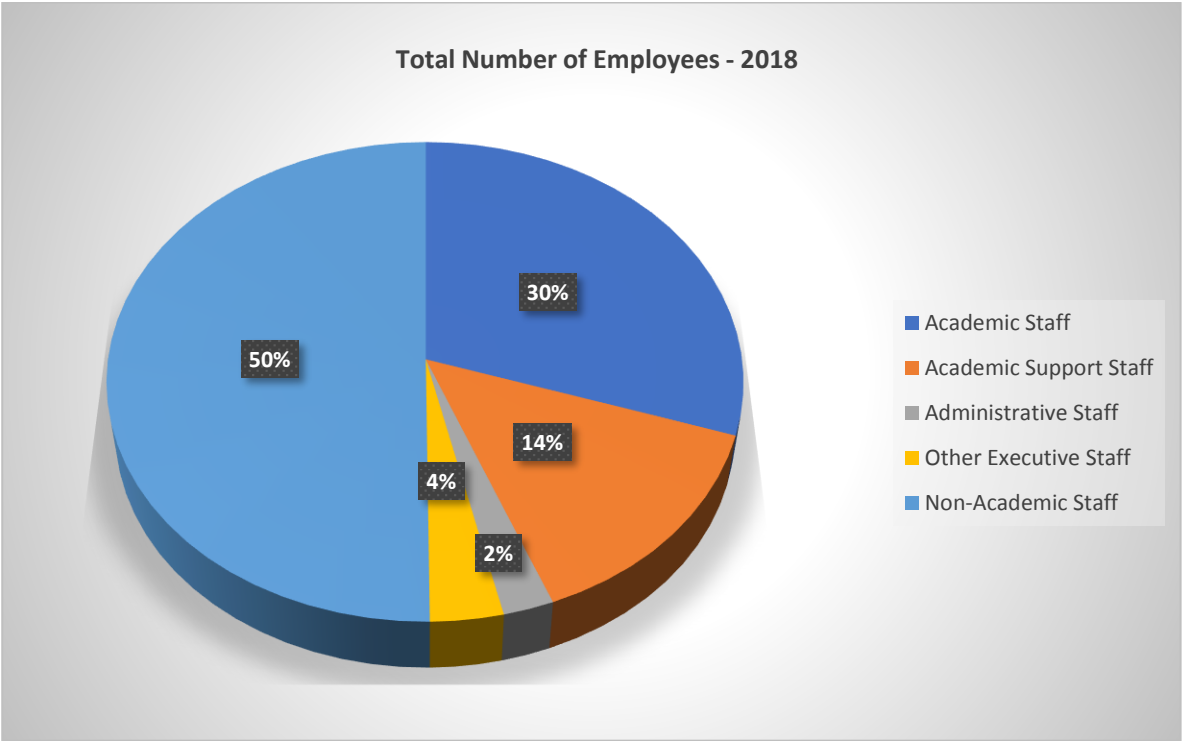

Chart 4.2.1 - Academic Staff by Category (2012 - 2018)

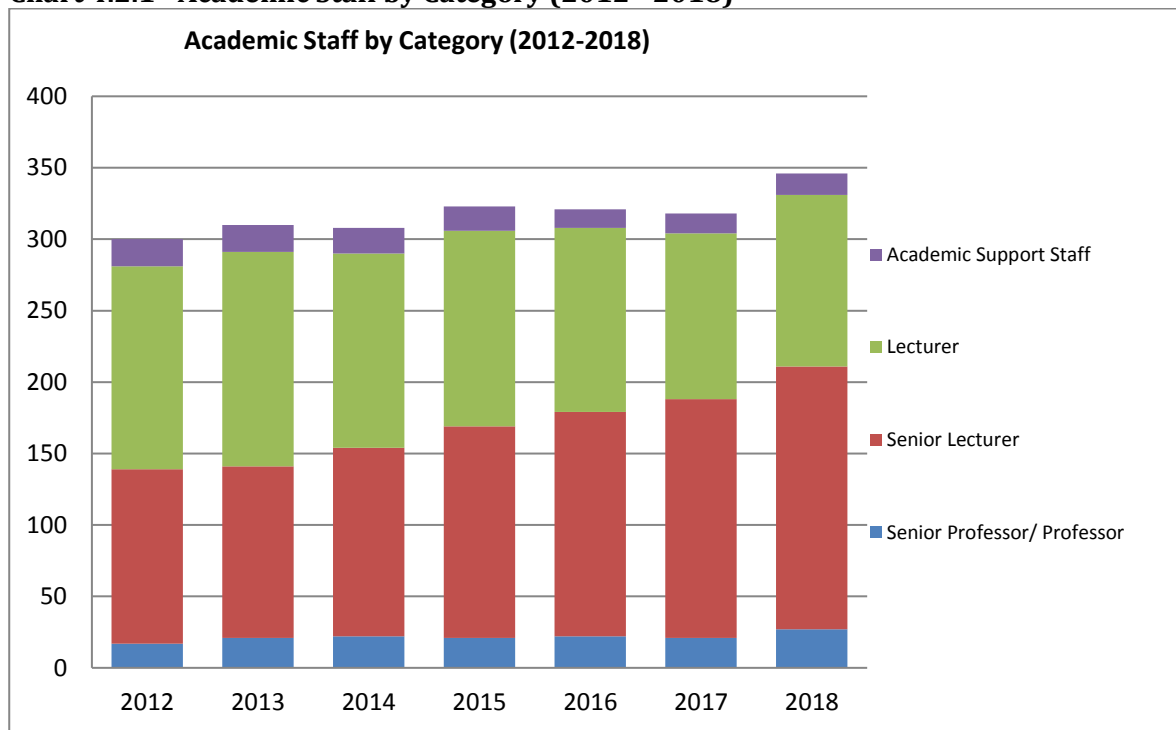

Chart 5.1.1 - Distribution of Revenue (2017-2018)

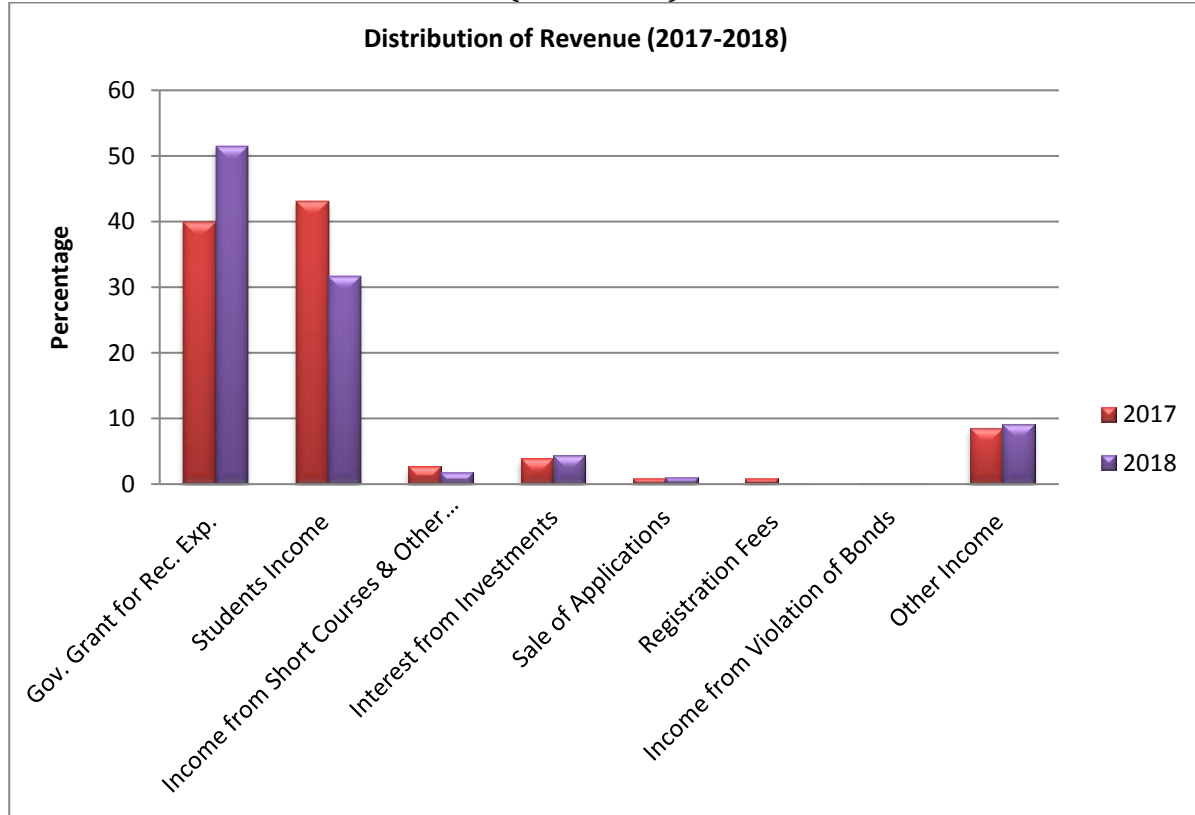

Chart 5.1.2 - Distribution of Expenses (2017 - 2018)

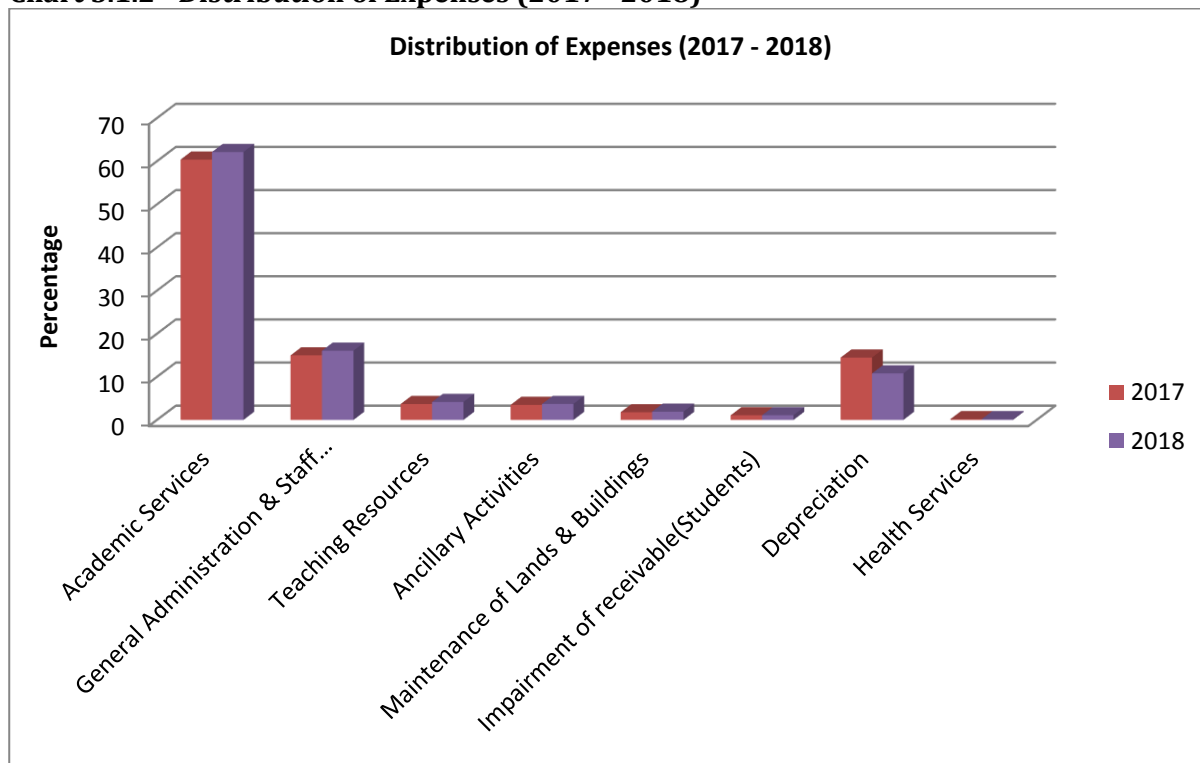

Chart 5.1.3 - Operating Expenses (2017-2018)

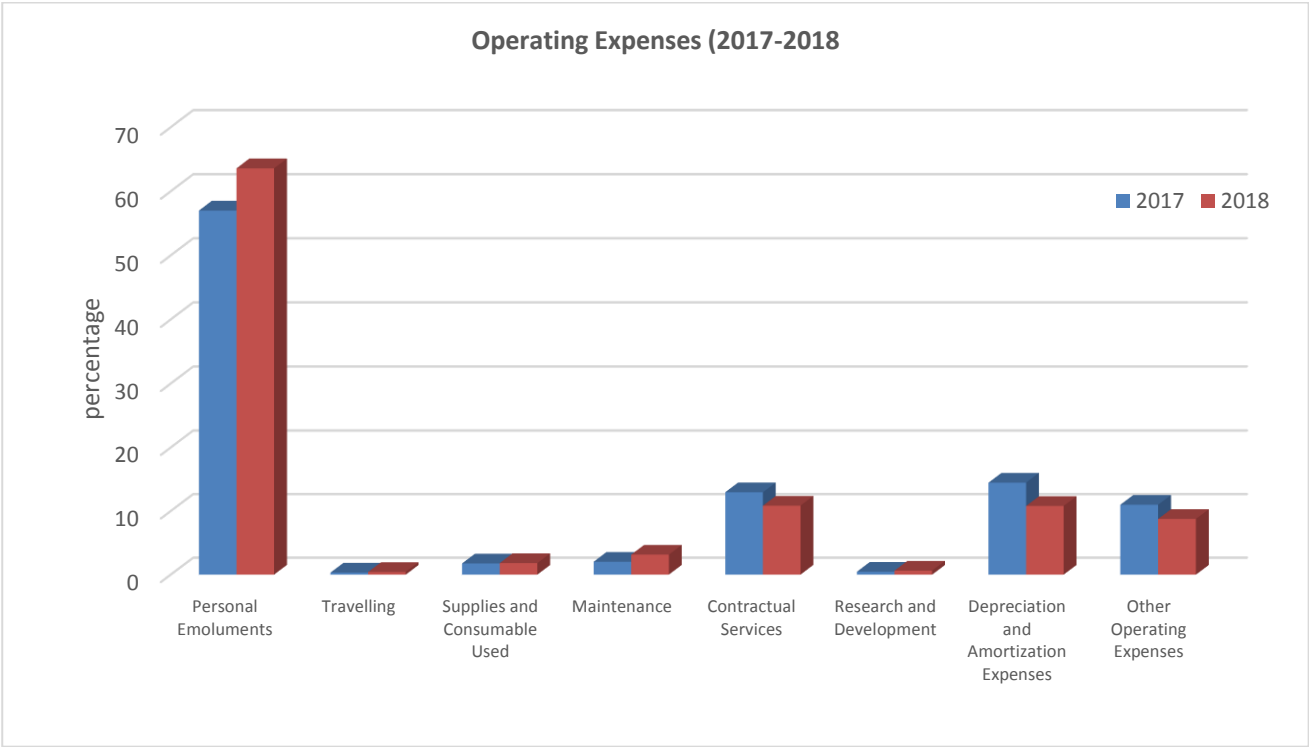

Chart 5.1.4 - Distribution of Capital Expenditure

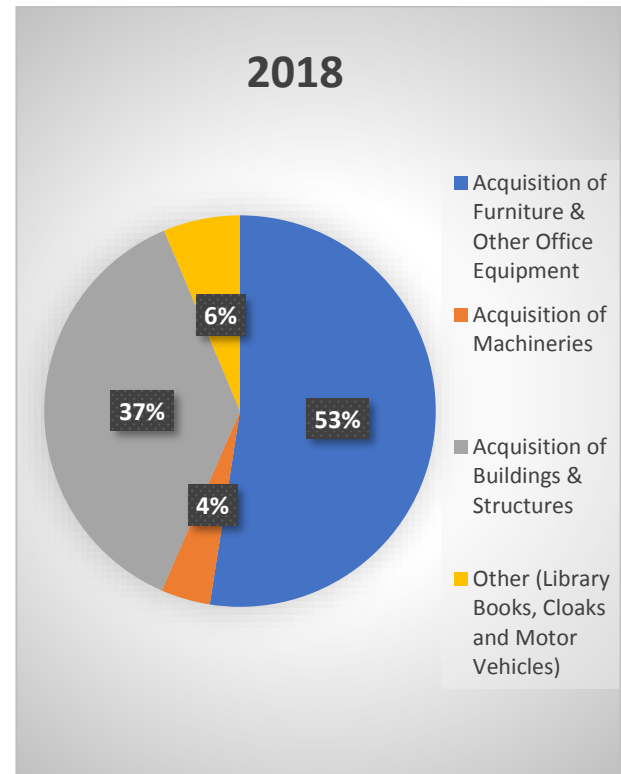
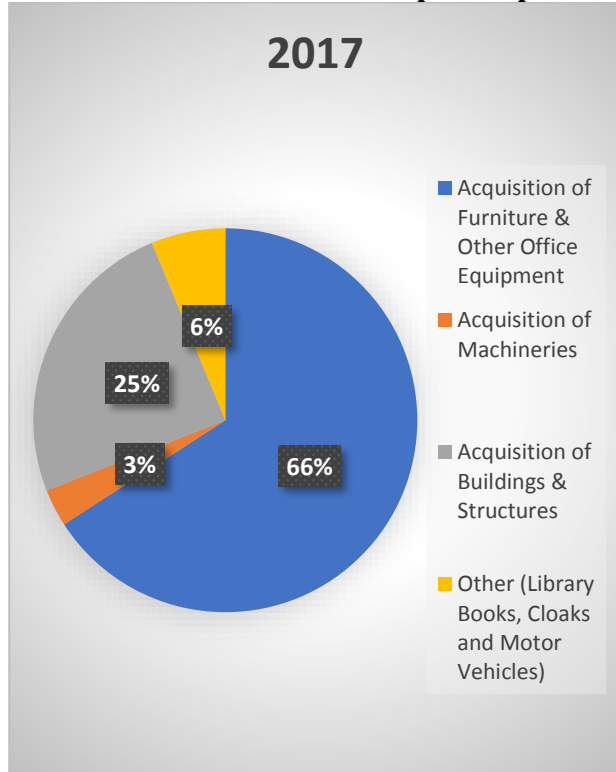
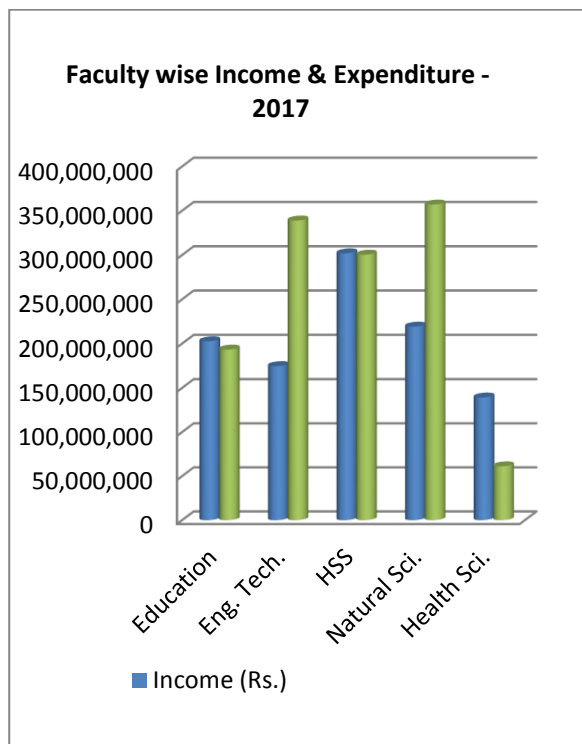


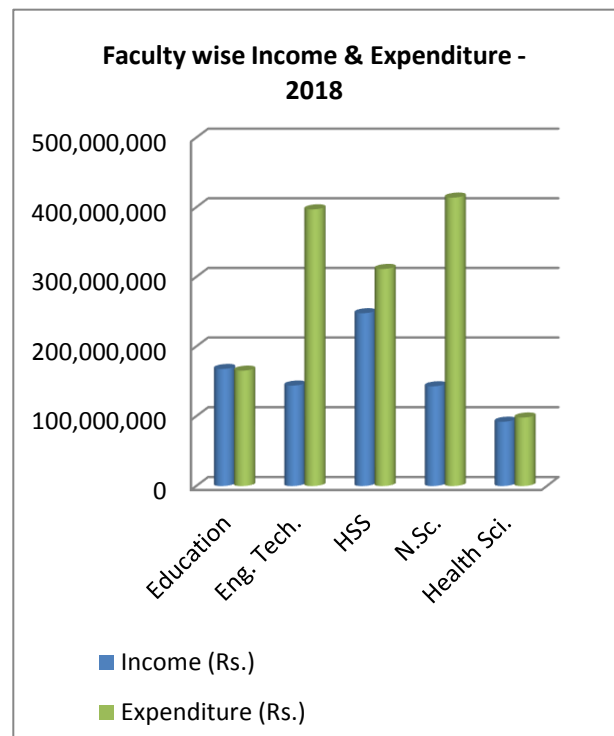
