  - Courses you wish to register for this academic year should be indicated with an 'X' in the first blank column of the Re-registration Form. You can decide the number of credits you want to register for this academic year up to a maximum of 30 credits, based on your capacity and time available for studies.
- **4.** IF YOU HAVE **NOT** COMPLETED THE COMPULSORY COURSES IN THE StART@OUSL PROGRAMME (ANNEXURE 4), YOU ARE ADVISED TO REGISTER AND COMPLETE THE PARTICULAR COURSES WITHIN THIS ACADEMIC YEAR (2022/23).
  - It is compulsory to register and pass LTE3401- English for General Academic Purposes (EGAP).
- 5. AFTER YOUR COURSE CHOICES ARE ENTERED TO THE COMPUTER SYSTEM BY STAFF AT THE REGISTRATION BLOCK, CHECK WHETHER THE COMPUTER-GENERATED PRINTOUT ACCURATELY LISTS ALL COURSES YOU INCLUDED IN THE RE- REGISTRATION FORM.

#### **Important Notice**

- 1. It is **COMPULSORY** that you **APPLY TO SIT FOR FINAL EXAMINATIONS** of each semester through MyOUSL using the 'Exam Registration' link before the deadline.

- 2<sup>nd</sup> semester examinations 2022/23 Apply between 27<sup>th</sup> June 2023 to 08<sup>th</sup> August 2023

If you have not registered to sit final exams online, from 2022/23, you may <u>NOT</u> be permitted to sit the final examinations.

2. If you wish to <u>CHANGE YOUR CENTER</u> when sitting for Final Examinations or Continuous Assessment Tests, inform the Head/Department of Nursing via email (hdnurse@ou.ac.lk) at the beginning of each semester of the Academic year.

Those who just turn up at a Regional centre without informing, may NOT be permitted to sit the CAT or Final examination.

# **Special Notices for Students**

## Please follow the given instructions

#### **Regarding Re-registration Counselling**

- It is **compulsory** to attend for re-registration counseling for the students registered under **BN programme structure** (Students registered on or before year 2014, Registration Numbers X14XXXXXX, X13XXXXXX, etc.). If the Re-registration form is not signed by the relevant counselor, you are not permitted to register for courses.
- When you are attending for re-registration counselling session, it is compulsory to present a hard copy of your recently downloaded (from MyOUSL) RESULT HISTORY/ SHEET and your progress checking document (Annexure 5)

# Regarding eligibility/ Overall Continuous Assessment Mark (OCAM)

• The eligibility (**OCAM**) for the courses of BSc <u>Honours</u> Nursing Degree Programme is valid only for **two academic years** including the registered year and one subsequent year. (**NGU and BSU coded courses**)

# **Regarding Centre Change**

• If you need to change your regional centre, you can make a request in writing to the Assistant Director of a centre to make the necessary changes in the computer system.

#### **Regarding Student Registration & Reregistration**

- You are allowed to register/reregister only during the specified registration given to you. The system will be automatically closed after the last date of the registration. After the deadline given no student requests will be entertained.
- You can add and/or drop courses only during the Add/Drop date.
- During the Drop date, you can only drop courses.

# **Regarding Renewal of Studentship**

• Renewal of studentship will be allowed up to six months from the commencement date of registration of a particular program.

# **Regarding Sitting examinations**

- You are eligible to sit for the examination if,
  - a. has an active registration for the particular Academic Year
  - b. has settled all due payments
  - c. has eligibility for the particular course

# Sitting examinations as Center Changed student

• If you wish to sit an examination as a "Center Changed' student in a different center other than the Academic center / examination center, that should be notified to the Head/ Department of Nursing (hdnure@ou.ac.lk) at least two weeks' before the examination date.

# **INSTRUCTIONS**

- (A) You are permitted to change courses by adding or dropping courses you previously registered for without any financial or academic penalty on add/drop date.
- (B) Check if the staff member has made the appropriate entry in the Student Registration Book.
- (C) Courses at a higher Level cannot be offered unless the minimum credit requirement specified is offered at the lower Level (for example, you cannot register for Level 6 courses, without having registration/exemption/EL for 30 credits at Level 5).
- (D) Courses at a lower Level cannot be dropped unless all courses offered at the higher Level are also dropped (for example, you cannot drop any Level 5 courses, unless you drop any courses registered at Level 6).
- (E) You are not allowed to add courses unless you have paid the full voucher sent to you without any changes. If you have got your voucher reduced, you cannot add courses based on additional fees paid.
- (F) Request for Add/Drop of courses will be entertained only **ONCE** per student per academic year.
- (G) Add/Drop form is available for download in the Department website. Students must fill sections 1 to 4 in the form and hand over the completed form to the Academic Counsellor.

#### DROPPING OF COURSES WITHOUT ACADEMIC PENALTY

Drop date: 05th January 2023 at Colombo Regional Centre Only

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- (A) There will be no academic penalty for courses dropped up to 05th January 2023. However, the 1<sup>st</sup> instalment paid (60%), in respect of the courses you drop must be forfeited.
- (B) Courses CANNOT be dropped at a lower Level unless those offered at a higher Level are also dropped.
- (C) A request for dropping of courses will be entertained only ONCE per student.
- (D) **Drop form is available for download in the Department website.** Students must fill the form and hand over the completed form to the Head of Department.
- (E) Once the form is signed by the Head, it is your responsibility to take it to Registration Desk and have the dropped of courses officially recorded in your Student Record Book and the Computer system.
